

The report summarizes the main findings of analyses of selected existing regional water protection action plans covering defined regional target areas and it prepares consolidated recommendations for implementation of good water management practices in the Baltic Sea Region (BSR).

In this transnational work the WATERPRAXIS project partners analyzed a set of existing action plans and realized water protection projects. These plans and projects addressed the most common water protection problems of the BSR countries and represented different types of measures and methods on water management, impact assessment, planning and organization. In addition to finding good examples/practices, also the barriers preventing/hindering the application of different measures or the practical implementation of plans and projects were identified.
